HIGHLIGHTS

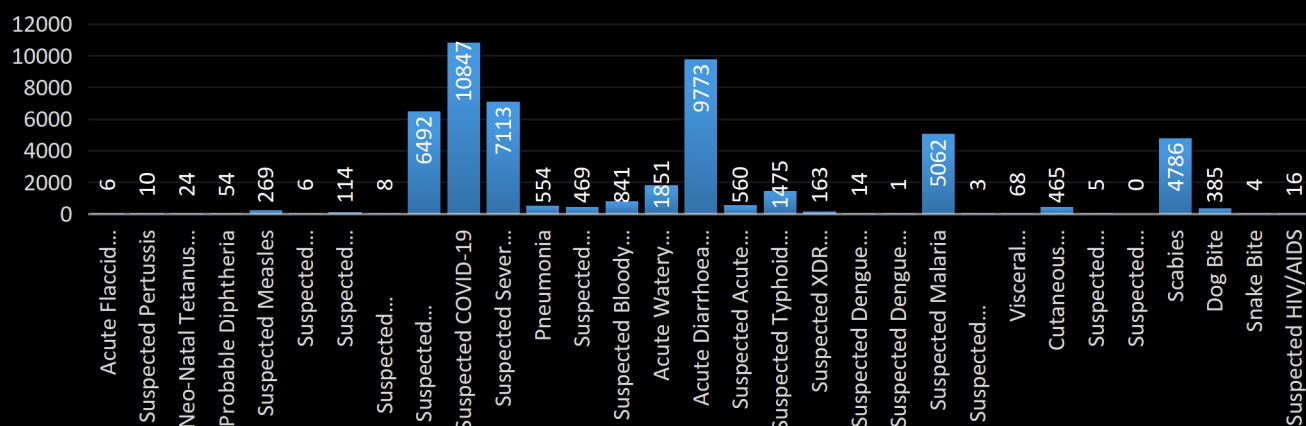
- Weekly IDSRS reports received from 1002 out of 1546 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa
- In week 13 total **52,062** COVID-19 lab tests were conducted and the positivity rate was **13.4%**
- Coordination Meeting was held with partners WHO, JSI & PHE on Thursday April 01, 2021 which was chaired by DG Health Services. The agenda of the meeting was to discuss existing surveillance network by clarifying the roles of PDSC & DDSC
- IDSRS provincial and district teams were assigned task by DG Health Services to clear the backlog of COVID-19 vaccination by entering the data in to COVIM system. IDSRS team along with EPI Coordinators gathered data of approx. 2500 vaccinated citizens/HCWs in week 13, which was shared to NCOC for clearance
- IDSRS team compiled and shared COVID-19 NCOC Sitrep, PCR and RAT reports, lab reports and logistic reports on daily basis from Public and Private labs of KP

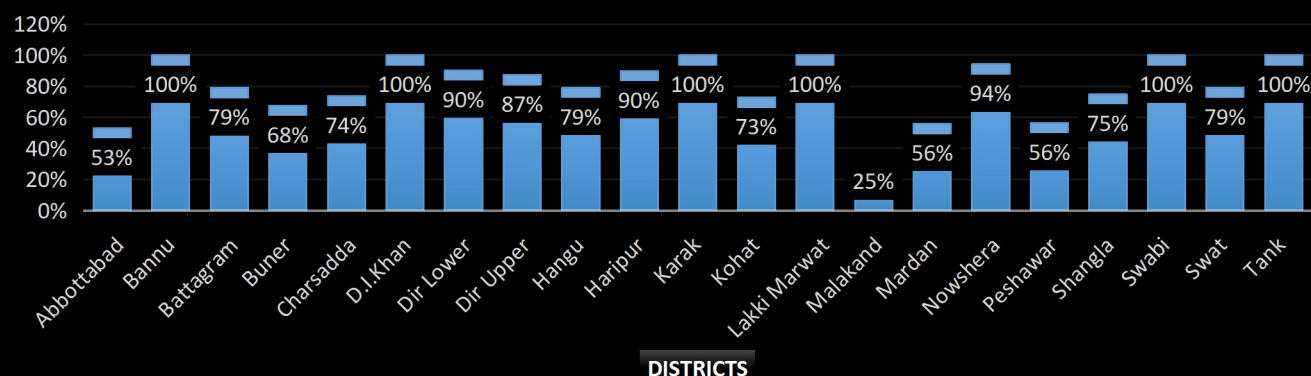
