

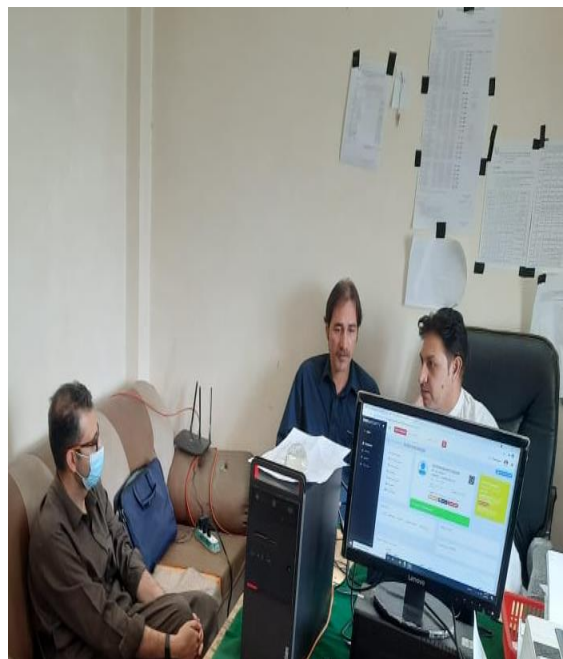

HIGHLIGHTS

- Weekly IDSRS reports received from 972 out of 1546 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa
- In week 14, total 56506 Covid-19 tests were conducted and the positivity rate was 15.4%.
- As directed by Secretary Health KP, the Program Manager and Surveillance Coordinator IDSRS had a meeting with RRT focal person in DHO office Peshawar to revisit the SOPs for RRTs and enhance Covid sampling in Peshawar and strengthen coordination with PHRL , KMU.
- Responding to an alert of acute watery diarrhea generated through IDSRS weekly report, Public Health Coordinator of Charsadda constituted an outbreak response team. Water samples collected from the area were tested and found unsafe for drinking. Line Departments were informed and health awareness messages were disseminated among the affected community and recommended chlorination of the point of source.
- IDSRS team compiled and shared COVID-19 NCOC Sitrep, PCR and RAT reports, lab reports and logistic reports on daily basis from Public and Private labs of KP.

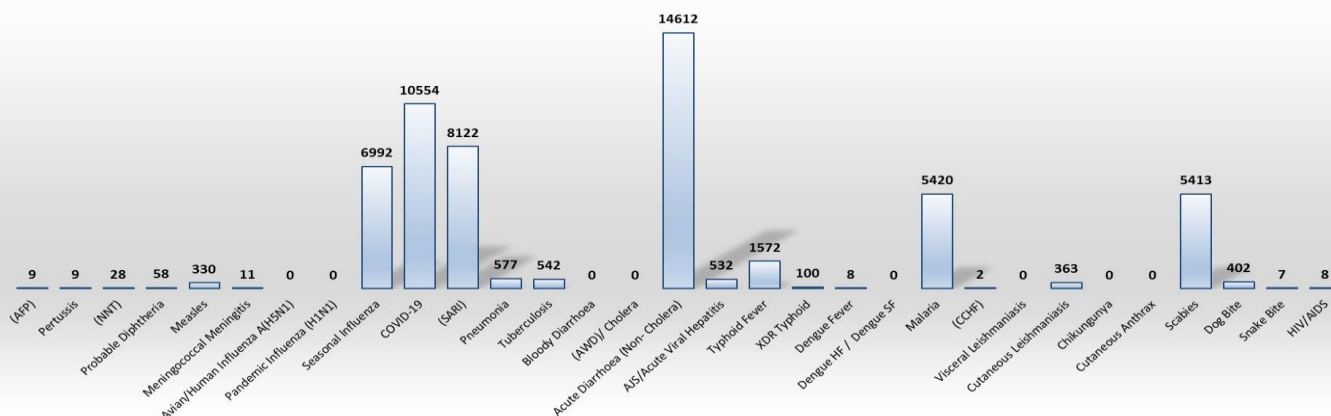

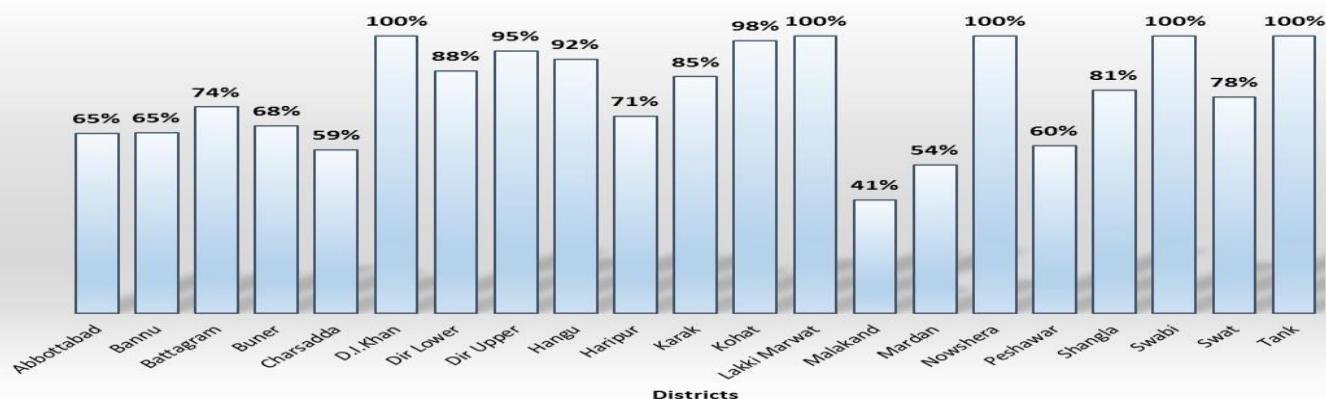
