## HIGHLIGHTS

- Weekly IDSRS reports received from 890 out of 1546 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- In week 23, total 65093 COVID tests were conducted and the positivity rate was 2.6%. As compared to previous week (3.9%) the positivity rate has decreased.
- In a meeting with NIH Islamabad, IDSRS KP team presented the Road map of IDSRS activities in KP. NIH agreed to support provincial server of DHIS-2 as reporting software of IDSRS in KP. Meeting was chaired by Dr. Jamil Ansari.
- Meeting with WHO provincial team held in IDSRS office to finalize cascade training in WHO supported districts.
- Water samples from Phase 2 area of Hayatabad were tested from PCSIR and it was found that the quality was not suitable for drinking. PDA department was informed to provide a response to the affected areas.
