

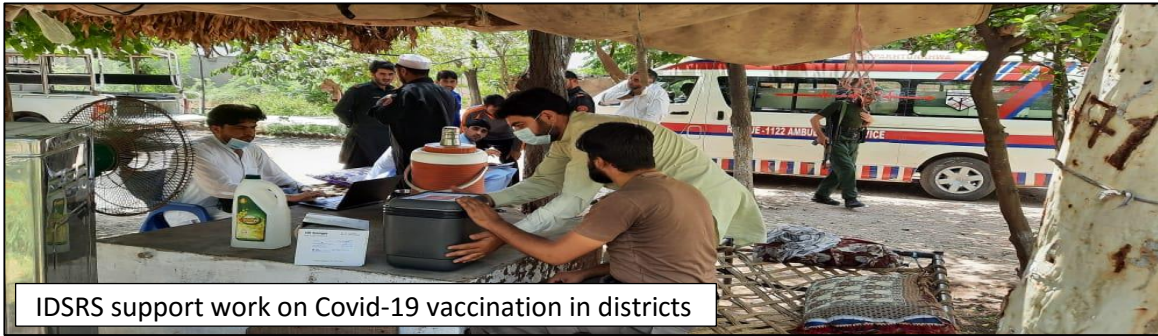

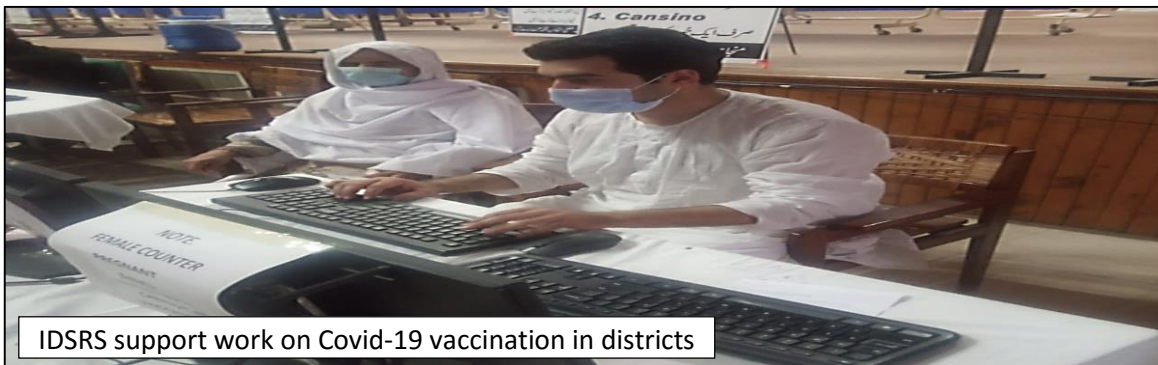

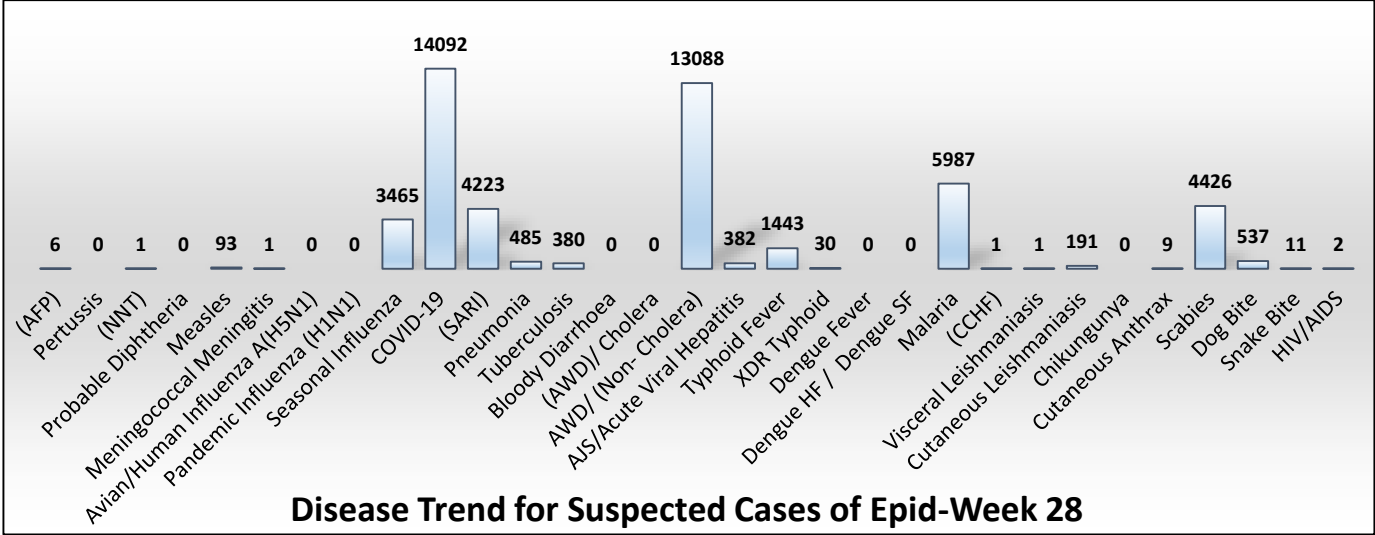
HIGHLIGHTS

- IDSRS weekly reports received from 935 out of 1546 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- In week 28, total 59170 COVID tests were conducted and the positivity rate was 3.2%. As compared to previous week (1.8%) the positivity rate has increased.
- IDSRS team welcomed Dr. Naikdad for joining on the position of Director Public Health DGHS. Dr. Naikdad appreciated the efforts of IDSRS, KP team in surveillance and response of diseases.
- Weekly zoom meeting was arranged with Public Health Coordinators of district Kohat and Haripur in which feedback was shared regarding week-27 data. It was also decided to arrange zoom meeting on weekly basis with all public health coordinators of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa to share the feedback and alerts.
- In response to new cases of COVID-19, IDSRS District teams are continuously involved in support work of Covid-19 vaccination.

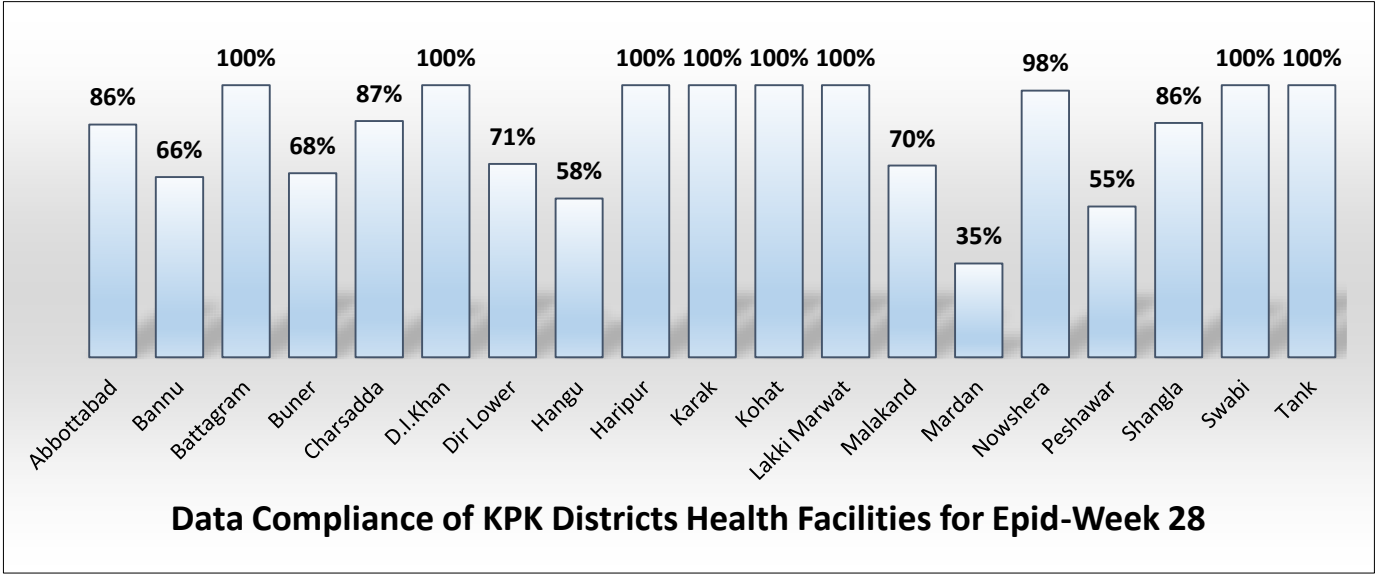

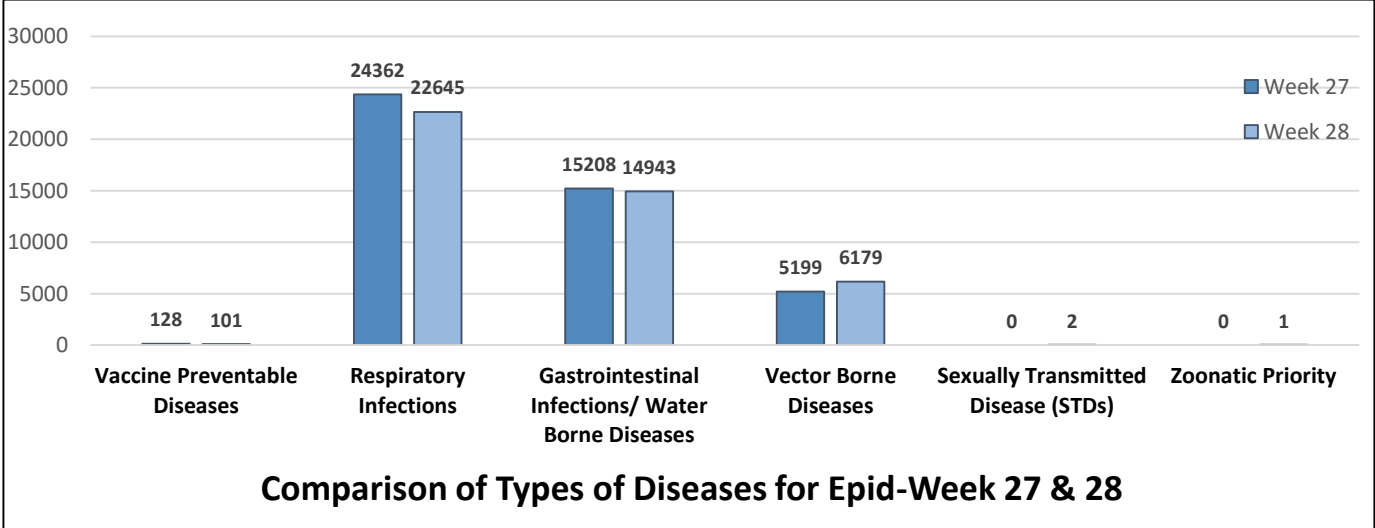
