HIGHLIGHTS

- IDSRS weekly reports received from 1398 out of 1578 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- In week # 06, total 80731 COVID tests were conducted in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and the positivity rate was 10%.
- During epidemiological week # 06, Suspected Vector borne diseases cases are reported higher as compared to week # 05. Rest of the communicable diseases have normal seasonal trend.
- In epidemiological week # 06, zero dengue cases were reported from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- IDSRS cascade training of district Mardan was held in last week with the support of UK Health Security Agency. In which total of 95 Public Health Staff including Doctors and Paramedics were trained on Diseases Surveillance, Infection Prevention Control, Risk Assessment & Communication, IDSRS Notified Diseases Case Definitions, Data Flow and DHIS2 Reporting Software.
- Last week in district Karak, Leishmaniasis outbreak was reported and investigated by Leishmaniasis team and conducted curative activity at village Fateh Sheri Killa Union Council Jahangeri Karak.
