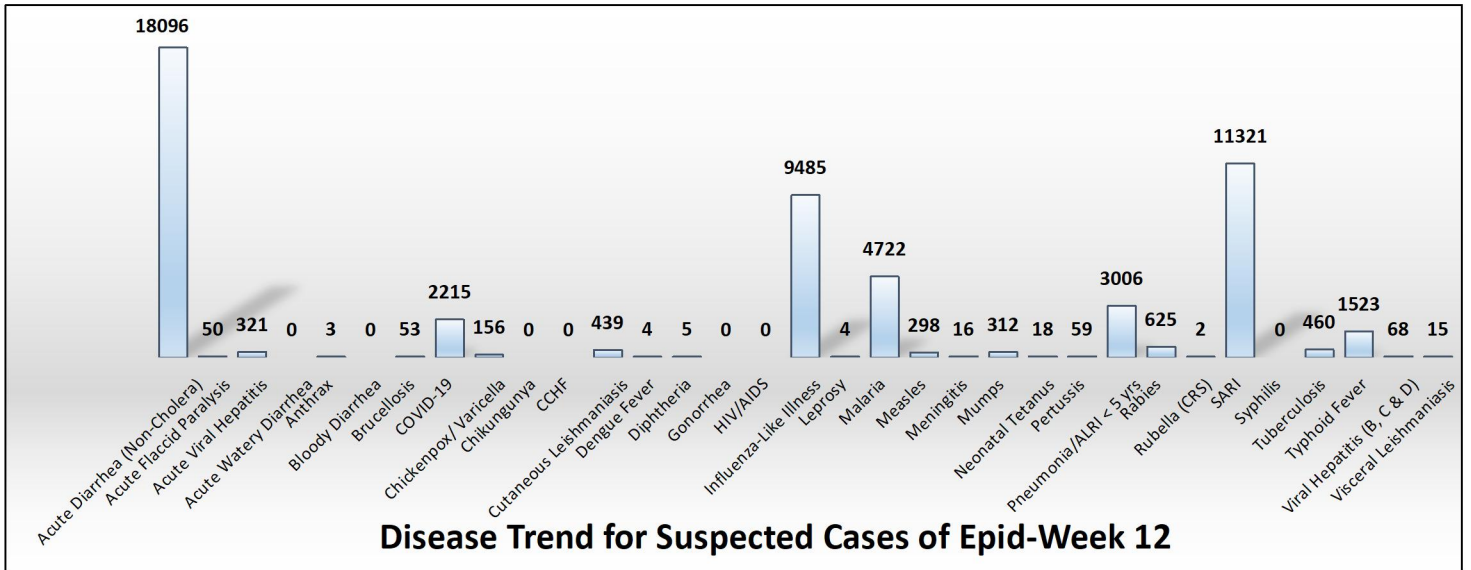

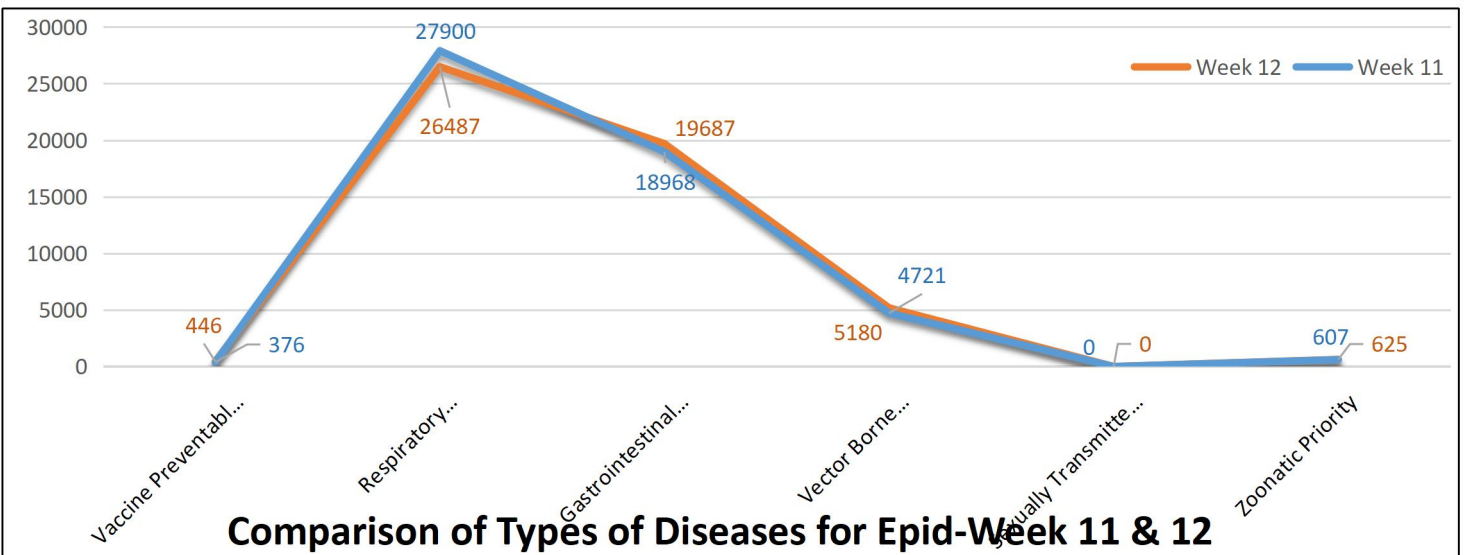

HIGHLIGHTS

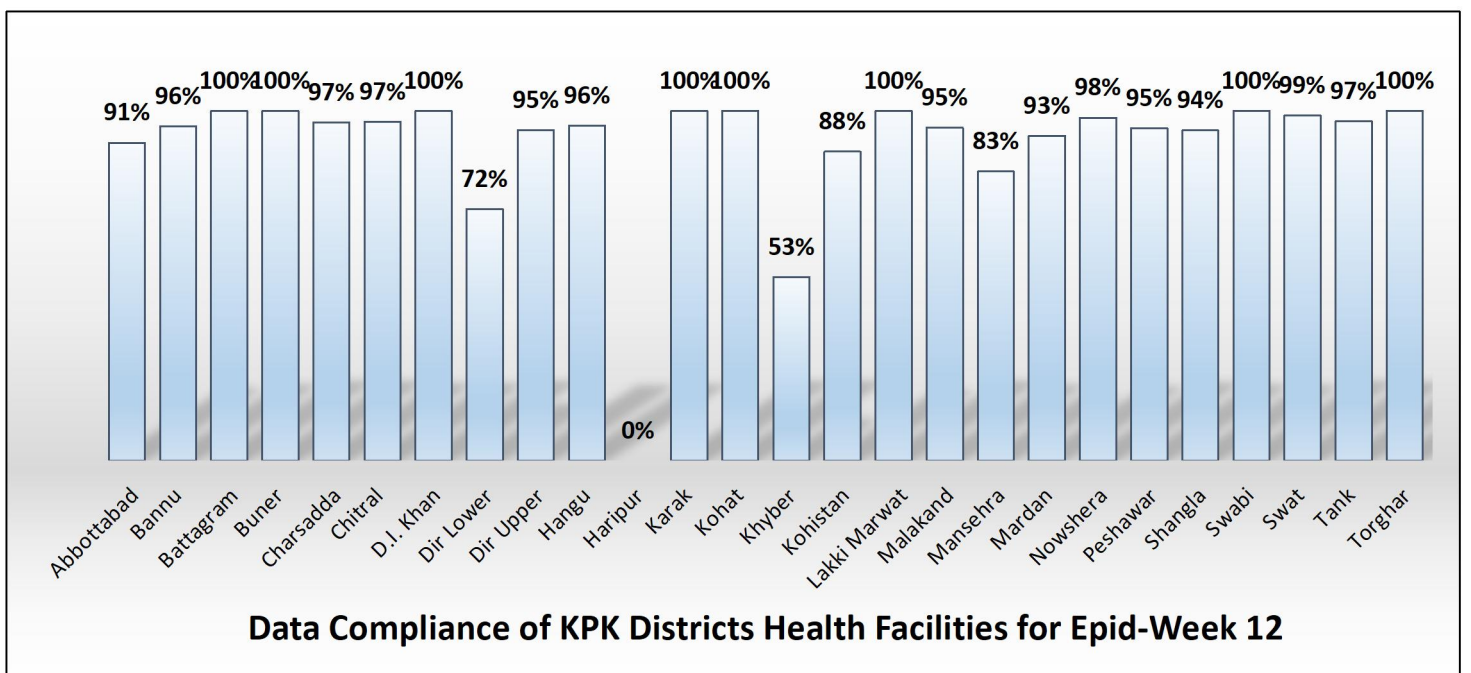
- IDSRS weekly reports received from 1401 out of 1578 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- In week # 12, total 46244 COVID tests were conducted in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and the positivity rate was 0.5%.
- A meeting with the Chief Health Officer was attended by IDSRS in which he was briefed regarding IDSRS activities. Furthermore he assured his maximum support to IDSRS.
- In response to media reports about diarrhoea cases and deaths in 6 hospitals of Peshawar, a team of IDSRS visited those hospitals and collected data and submitted report the Director Public Health. Contrary to the report there was normal distribution of cases in these hospitals.
- Scabies cases were reported from district Hangu with DHO office providing the necessary response in the affected community.
- A refresher orientation session was being conducted in DHO office Lakki Marwat in order to strengthen and upgrade the capabilities & responsibilities of Lady Health Supervisors (LHSs) & Lady Health Workers (LHWs) for Dengue In-door Surveillance.
