HIGHLIGHTS

- Weekly IDSRS reports received from 1018 out of 1546 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- In week 15, total 51625 COVID tests were conducted and the positivity rate was 16.2%. As compared to previous week (15.4%) the positivity rate has been increased.
- In a meeting of handing over of command and control center to health department by JSI, Program Manager IDSRS presented to the forum IDSRS reporting mechanism through which weekly bulletins are generated and highlighted the issues being faced in providing a timely response to these alerts/threats.
- IDSRS TOT for EPI Coordinators is planned for 27-29th April in Peshawar with the support of WHO.
- Response to alerts generated through weekly bulletin in week 14 have been provided by Public Health Coordinators in their respective districts.
- IDSRS team compiled and shared COVID-19 NCOC Sitrep, PCR and RAT reports, lab reports and logistic reports on daily basis from Public and Private labs of KP.
