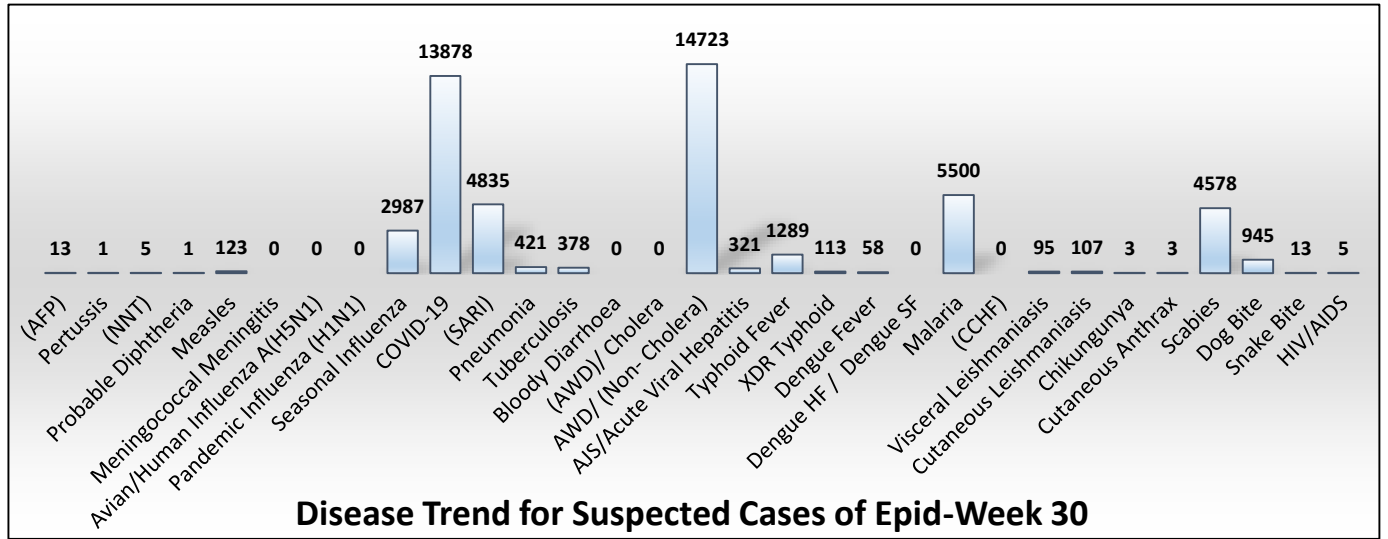
HIGHLIGHTS

- IDSRS weekly reports received from 931 out of 1546 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- In week 30, total 69602 COVID tests were conducted and the positivity rate was 5.9%. As compared to previous week (3.4%) the positivity rate has increased.
- A meeting was held with partners, WHO, PHE and JSI under chairmanship of Additional Director General and Director Public Health in which roadmap for IDSRS and integration of different surveillance system were discussed.
- Dengue positive cases from District Upper Dir and Swat were reported by Shaukat Khanum laboratory in Peshawar. Response provided by Public Health Coordinators of the respective districts.
- Suspected case of CCHF reported from Ayub Teaching Hospital, Abbottabad. Case response provided by Public Health Coordinator.

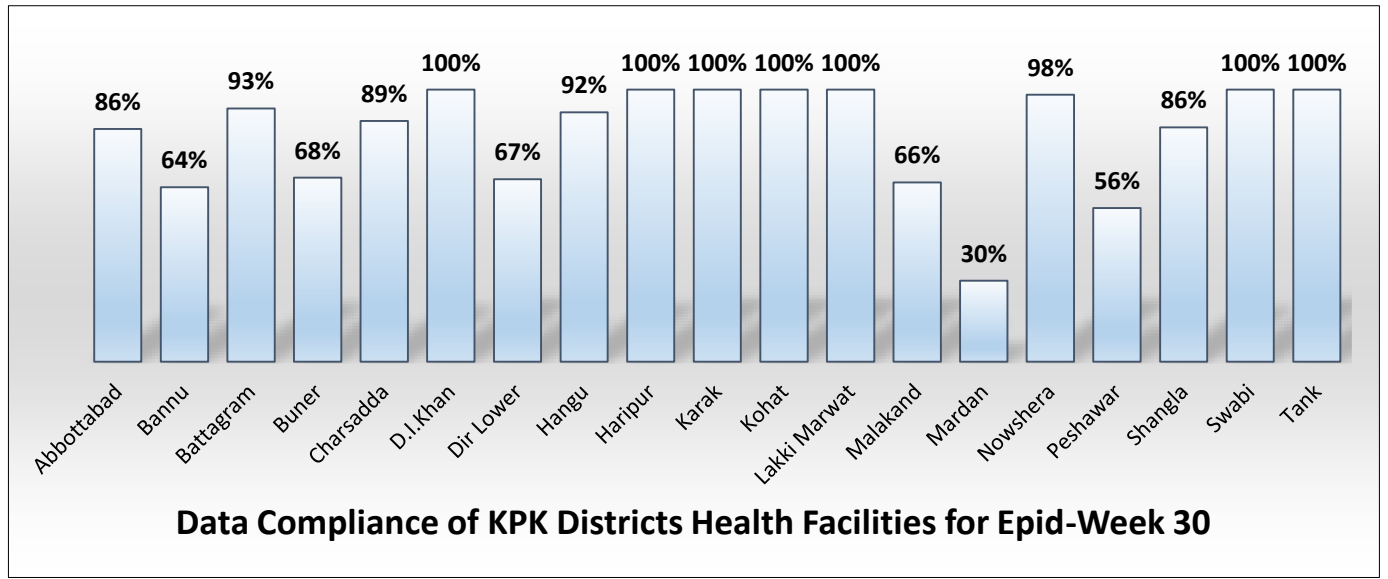

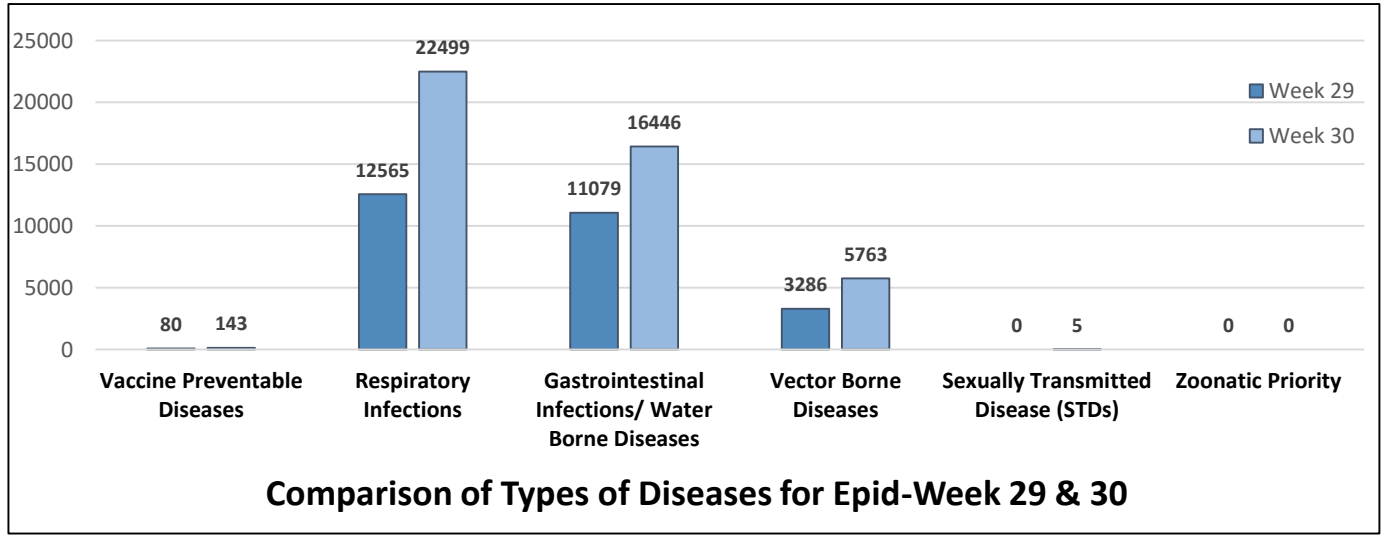
