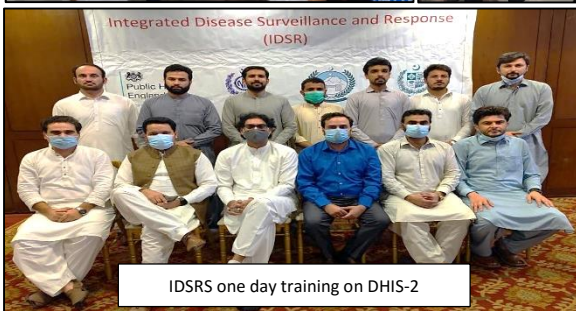

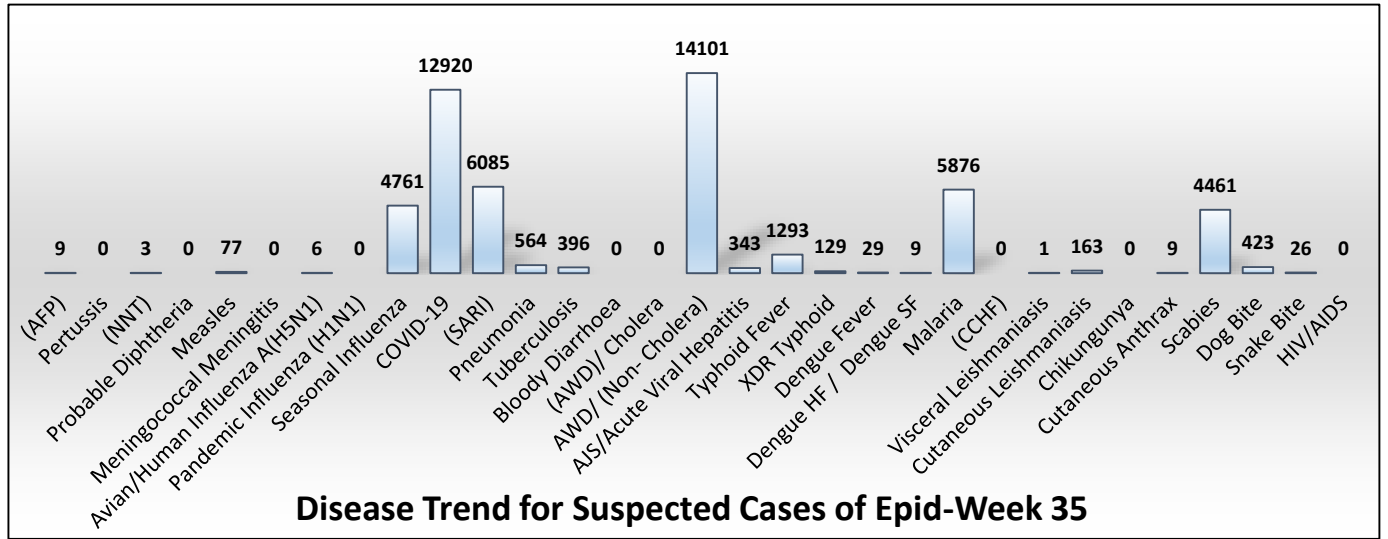
HIGHLIGHTS

- IDSRS weekly reports received from 935 out of 1546 health facilities of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- In week 35, total 72161 COVID tests were conducted and the positivity rate was 6.7%. As compared to previous week (7.1%) the positivity rate has decreased.
- Country Head WHO, visited IDSRS Provincial office and provided support by donating IT equipment.
- National Institute of Health had a review meeting with IDSRS KP team on DHIS-2 implementation.
- One day training on DHIS-2 for data team IDSRS held at PC Peshawar with the support of Public Health England.
- In a response to dengue cases from canal road Sufaid dheri, district Peshawar IDSRS team identified the high risk areas and shared a report to DHO Peshawar for fogging and elimination of vector. LHW coordinator informed to conduct household communication activity for dengue prevention.
- A joint meeting of NIH Islamabad, HIV/AIDS program and IDSRS KP held under the chair of Additional Director General for strengthening of HIV surveillance.

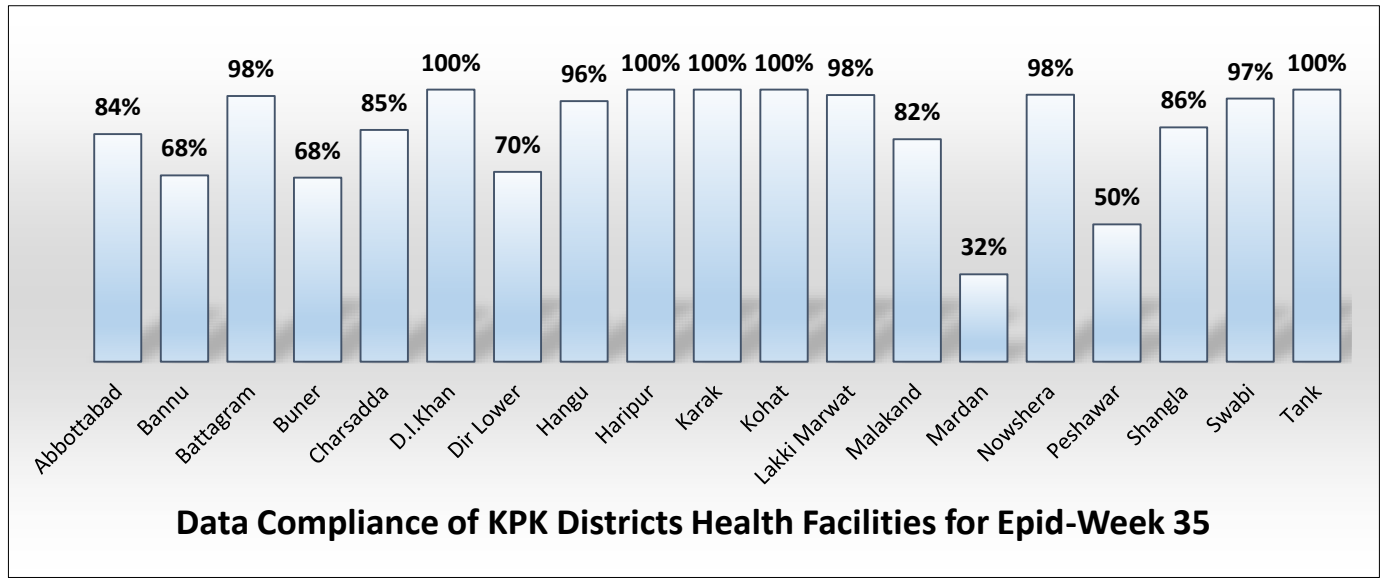

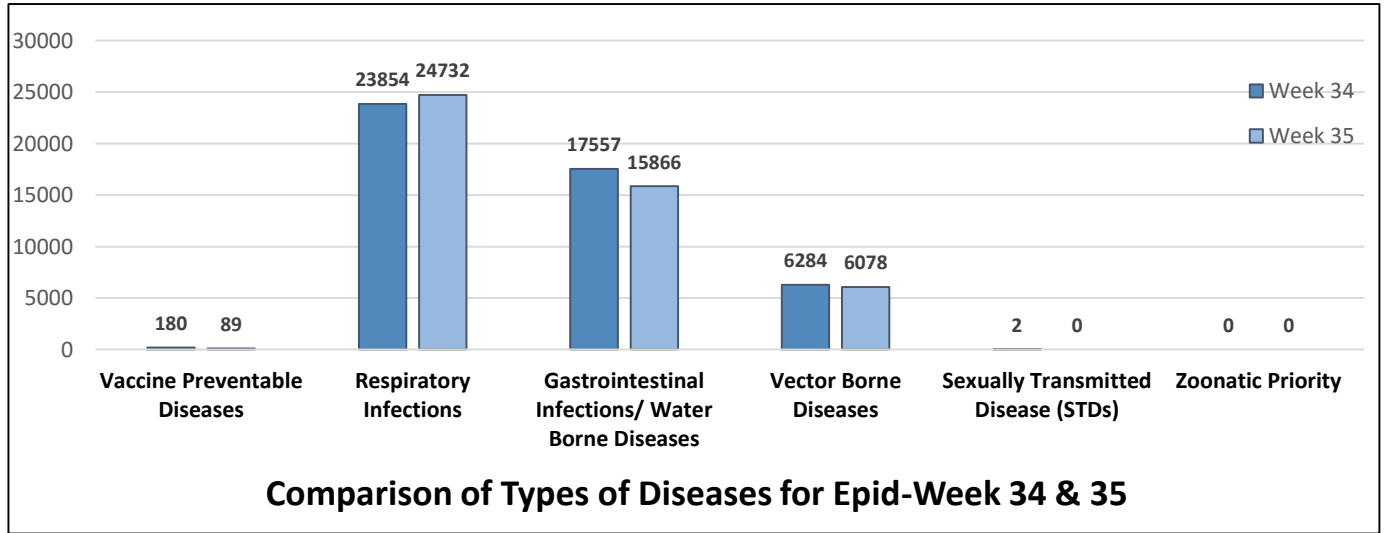
